## TOURNAMENT CHECK LIST

- T Make checks payable to:  
Kingman Softball Association
- T Make sure Official ASA Roster is completed properly.
- T Complete and mail ASA roster, entry form and check. This must be received by June 22, 2007.
  
- 1 COACHES MEETING - FRIDAY - 5:00PM AT CENTENNIAL PARK, FIELD #4 BY THE 1<sup>ST</sup> BASE BLEACHERS.
  
- 1 GAMES START AT 6:00PM

Each team will have a warm-up game. The tournament will then continue into a double elimination format.

## GENERAL INFORMATION

- A. AWARDS:  
Sponsor awards to the top 3 teams.  
Individual awards to the top 2 teams.
- B. UNIFORMS:  
All players must compete in like uniforms. Shorts or long pants may be missed. Coaches must either be in team uniforms or dressed alike in the team colors. If one coach is in a team uniform, the other coach must be neatly attired in the team color. Please see the ASA official playing rules – Rule 3, Section 6 for complete information. Tournament director may make exceptions.
- C. LINE-UPS:  
Three line-up cards will be provided in the packet, others may be obtained through the scorekeepers. An official line-up must be submitted to the scorekeeper at least 15 minutes prior to the scheduled game time.
- D. GAME TIMES:  
Please follow the times listed on the tournament bracket; official clock is in the scorer's booth. Game time is forfeit time. Teams should be prepared to start a game once the preceding game is completed. Time limit – No new inning after 1 1/2 hour. Tie breaker after 7 innings, or 1 1/2 hour, whichever comes first.
- E. INFIELD PRACTICE:  
No infield practice will be permitted. Warm-up is allowed in designated areas only. Teams may warm-up in the outfield grass if time permits.
- F. BENCH AREA:  
Players, coaches, and sponsors, are the only individuals allowed in the bench area.
- G. PROTESTS:  
The tournament committee will decide all protests. As manager, please be familiar with rules of the game including proper protest procedures. See ASA playing Rule 9.
- H. RUN RULE:  
The 8 runs after 4 1/2 or 5 innings and 15 runs after 3 innings rule is in effect. Complete innings must be played unless the home team scores the total to go ahead by the limit while at bat.  
\*\*\*Tie-breaker: will be used at the end of 7 innings or 1 hour 30 minutes, whichever occurs first.

I. RAIN DELAY:

In the event of rain or any cause which interrupts a game the game must be resumed at the exact point where it was stopped. It is the manager's responsibility to report to the scoring booth for additional information. In the event the tournament can't be completed within the scheduled time frame and more than forty-percent (40%) of the scheduled games have been completed, the official final order of finish will be determined by the position of the teams in the bracket.

- i. The team which advanced the farthest in the winner's bracket.
- ii. Won-loss records, except among undefeated teams.
- iii. If only two teams are tied for a position and have played each other, the tie goes to the winner of the game. **Exception:** If there are only two teams remaining and each have one loss, the championship must be played or the teams shall be declared co-champions.
- iv. The teams shall be ranked according to the fewest runs allowed per game.

J. HOME TEAM:

The Home Team is determined by a coin toss on the field, by the umpire, prior to the start of each game.

K. TEAM DUGOUT SEATING:

The team at the top of the bracket will use the 1<sup>st</sup> base dugout. The team listed on the bottom of the bracket will use the 3<sup>rd</sup> base dugout.

L. GAME RULES:

All playing rules and regulations for the tournament will be governed by the 2007 ASA Official Guide and Rule Book.

M. CONDUCT:

Managers and coaches are asked to have complete control of their players and spectators both on and off the field.

N. ELIGIBILITY:

Please see the 2007 ASA Guide for clarifications and interpretations.

O. SOURVENIRS:

Souvenir T-Shirts and other merchandise will be available throughout the weekend.

P. ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES/PETS/GLASS ITEMS:

No alcoholic beverages may be brought into any of the parks. They are sold in the concession stand. Pets are not allowed inside the sports complex areas. Glass items are prohibited in the sports complex.
